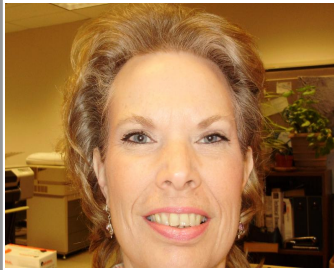

DATA CENTER UPGRADE

Haberberger, in collaboration with Benson Electric, has been awarded the Data Center Upgrade Project at Fontbonne University. Benson and Haberberger will be updating the University's main data center in Ryan Hall. This project is scheduled for completion prior to the fall semester and entails

extensive upgrades and expansion of the cooling, UPS and wire management systems. **Mike Schlautman** of Benson Electric Company and **Hewie Powell** with Haberberger completed extensive field investigation for this design-build project and look forward to providing Fontbonne University with a stronger, more energy efficient data center.

WHITEHALL CLUB

In June 2011, Haberberger was selected as the design-build contractor for a heating system improvement project for the Whitehall Club, a high-rise condominium building near the heart of Clayton, Missouri. This project consists of the complete replacement of four sets of heating hot water risers that travel up 17 stories and serve more than 80 individual fan coil units. The work also includes furnishing and installing a new air handling unit in the equipment room, along with new in-line pumps and an air separator. Major subcontractors on this project will include JEN Mechanical for the sheet metal work, Thornburgh Insulation, Benson Electric and Senco Services for testing and balancing. **Ron Arbuthnot** has been selected as Haberberger's Foreman to supervise the work in the field and **Tim Schneider** will be serving as project manager.

MARYVILLE UNIVERSITY LAB RENOVATION PROJECT

Haberberger Inc. has been selected to provide design-build services for Maryville University located in Town and Country, Missouri. The scope of the project is to renovate laboratory spaces inside of Kernaghan Hall. Haberberger is providing a complete code compliant design build HVAC.

John Gallia, with the assistance of **Jeff Haberberger** is providing the design, engineering, and construction administration associated with the project. **Steve Brightman** is the general foreman on the project.

FRANCIS HOWELL MEMBRANE TREATMENT FACILITY

Haberberger, Incorporated was recently awarded a contract by Brinkmann Constructors to expand the existing wastewater treatment facility at Francis Howell High School in St. Charles County. The project includes setting two new membrane treatment tanks, converting the existing tanks to preaeration tanks and all associated piping. The project is broken down into three phases and must be completed prior to the start of school this fall. **Jeff Roberts** is the project manager and **Doug Coonrod** is the general foreman.

JEFFERSON CITY WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY (JCWRF)

Haberberger, Incorporated is completing the mechanical portion of the project to add ultraviolet treatment at the JCWRF. **Clay Buxton**, general foreman, and **Jeff Roberts**, project manager, are working with Sircal Contracting to accomplish substantial completion by the end of June 2011.

Haberberger's work includes tying 54" ductile iron pipe into existing effluent piping to route plant effluent into the U.V. facility prior to discharge. When the 54" lines were each tied in, a portion of the plant had to be shut down, thus making the work critical. In both cases, the Haberberger crew finished ahead of schedule.

SAFETY DEPARTMENT HAPPENINGS

In December, Haberberger employees were given the opportunity to participate in CPR & First Aid training. During this training, the instructor elaborated on how Automatic Electric Defibrillator (AED) and Oxygen on site have increased the percentage of a victim surviving a heart attack. It was also mentioned that the first 5 minutes during an attack are the most critical for the victim.

On May 5, 2011, Haberberger took a major step and purchased an Automatic Electric Defibrillator (AED) and Oxygen cabinet for the office. Employees from the shop/office received training on the proper operation and use of the AED and Oxygen unit. The units are located in the office on the South wall near the computer server room.
