

Haberberger Wins Three Awards from MCA of Eastern Missouri

Company honored for its piping work

ST. LOUIS — Mechanical contracting firm, Haberberger Inc., has received three Outstanding Mechanical Installation Awards from the Mechanical Contractors Association (MCA) of Eastern Missouri for its work on projects for Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) and Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals.

Haberberger was also recognized for outstanding process piping work in the category of projects between \$600,000 and \$2 million for its work on a demineralizer project at Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals in Hazelwood, Missouri. The project was led by Pat Reiller, project manager, and Dodd Slawson, pipefitter general foreman.

The MCA of Eastern Missouri recognizes companies and projects with its Outstanding Mechanical Installation Awards bi-annually. The awards are judged based on criteria that includes quality of the installation, the working relationship between owner and contractor, and the project's appearance.
